

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The seventeenth **Annual General Meeting** of Shatin Anglican Church will be held at the Tsang Shiu Tim Secondary School Hall, Wo Che Estate on **Sunday 9th March, 2008** immediately after the 10am service.

At the meeting we will:

- 1. Elect a **Church Committee** for the period until the next Annual Meeting in 2009.
- 2. Receive **Reports** concerning the life of the Church. Reports are due in **by Monday 25th February** please.





The Electoral Roll is our church membership of those who are eligible to vote at the Annual Church Meeting (this year will be on Sunday 9th March). It is now open for enrolment until Sunday 25th Feb. Those who are already on the ER need not re-apply; a copy of the 2007 roll is enclosed for your reference.

To join the roll you need to be 18 years old or above, baptized, regularly attending Shatin Church, and not on the roll of any other church in Hong Kong. You must fill in the enrolment form which is available at the back of the hall or from the Church Office.

Registered members may nominate other members for one of the EIGHT elected Committee positions. **Nominations close on 25th February** and should be handed in by then. The 2007 elected Committee members were Brent Hauser, Evelyn Yan, James Low, Matthew Peacock, Paul Fox, Susie Young, Vanaja Jesudian, and the Treasurer, Linda Chan, attends meetings also.

OUR GIVING

FROM PETER MAYYAM

Dear Shatin Church,

Greetings and blessings to you!

I know I get busy for the ministry at times and forget to write or update you so please forgive me.. I just wanted you to know how much we appreciate your friendship and partnership in the Kingdom building and will always treausre you and consider you a great part of us and the ministry the Lord has called us to do.

I am forwarding you some pictures of recent ministry involvements. Last Feb. 6-8 - my elder brother (Rev. Pepe Mayyam) group of churches Pastors and Church Leaders in Bible Christian Fellowship and our small group of Pastors and church leaders at Lifeway Bible Church had first joint Revival Conference in Ramon, Isabela. It was a time of bonding for Rev. Pepe Mayyams' Pastors and church leaders at Bible Christian Fellowship with our small group of pastors and church leaders of Lifeway Bible Church, and a time to come together for worship and to seek the Lord together especially for the transition of possibly me taking the oversight which up to now am not sure if this is of the Lord. I know my brother is still very strong and able but feels he would like to slow down a bit. I took most of the daytime sessions (which was so exhausting and draining) and my brother spoke at all the 3 evening meetings and presided over the business meetings. From the conference, my wife and daughter and I proceeded to visit one of our new and small but growing congregation in Caragasan, Ifugao. We started this church 5 years ago and the building 3 years ago which until now is unfinished but atleast they have a shed from the heat and rains. From there we drove another 10 hrs to visit one of our church in Abra and we are looking to help them buy a drum set for their church.

One of the pictures am forwarding is a building we are looking to move to for our church here in La Trinidad. We are still negotiating. It is for sale for Seven Million pesos or \$175,000 US dollars but we do not have the money. It is also for rent to own at P140,000 pesos or \$3,500 US dollars monthly but we don't have that money either. But we offered to rent the whole building for P40,000 pesos monthly and that is do-able for us as we are looking to rent out the first and second floors of the building and have the 3rd and fourth floor for the church.

Next week, I am hosting a pastors and church leaders seminar in our church in La Trinidad. The participants will come from the 20 plus churches of the Benguet Evangelical Assoc. of Ministers that I chair.

We are also looking to buy a small piece of land for a future church bldg for our newest outreach in La Union.

All these we need your fervent prayers. We are praying and hope your church will sent a team sometime in the nearest future to minister and visit us and the ministry we are doing. Thank you so much.

I hope the pictures will come alright as am using an almost dinosour computer and it takes long time to attach pictures, am praying to be replaced soon and Thank you very much for your partnership for the ministry in the Northern Philippines.

Dynamics and Disciplines of Following Jesus

<u>Stuart Briscoe</u> will be speaking on "Brave Enough to Follow," an extended study of how Jesus discipled Simon Peter. 
