

TYPHOON & STORM — If the Typhoon Signal 8 or the Black Storm Warning is hoisted, all service or meetings at Shatin Church are cancelled. Please check your radio before setting out for Church in bad weather. Continue to pray for the victims of recent earthquake and cyclone in China and Burma. In Sichuan, the devastation is being revealed as rescue workers make contact with victims in the worst-hit areas. Soldiers and emergency workers rushed to the quake zone found towns reduced to rubble, thousands dead or trapped and dazed survivors grieving for loved ones and trying to come to terms with the catastrophe. In some areas up to 80 per cent of the buildings had collapsed in Monday's 7.8 magnitude quake, the worst to strike China in more than three decades.

Pray for all those seeking to bring aid to those in need. Pray that political or social upheaval will not hinder or disrupt the aid efforts.

Give thanks to God for the day to day peace and stability that we enjoy in Hong Kong and pray that we will not take it for granted.

[1 Tim 2 verse 1 to 4] "I urge, then, first of all, that requests, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for everyone - for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness.
