

# CHURCH PRAYER REQUESTS

Prayers for the third Sunday after Trinity

God our saviour, look on this wounded world in pity and in power; hold us fast to your promises of peace won for us by your Son, our Saviour Jesus Christ.

As we pray for our wounded world we continue to pray for those suffering as a result of natural disaster or the sinful actions of other people. We pray for the deep seated healing of people and the nations that can come only through the work of God's grace in our hearts.

We pray for other Christian congregations in Hong Kong – this week we remember "City Church International" that meets in the YMCA Mong Kok. Pray for Pastor Rob Rufus and the congregation as they pray to be empowered to further serve God's Kingdom in Hong Kong.

Pray for Wendy Blackmur in hospital that the doctors and nurses may be able to diagnose the root cause of the pain she is experiencing in her leg and that they would find the appropriate treatment to bring complete healing.

This week we think about pleasing God with the way we spend our time. Ask God to help us to please him in how we spend time in work, rest and recreation and may the way we live our lives bless those around us and also stand as a witness to God's pattern for life.

Use these verses to prayerfully reflect on all that comes to us in this life and how we are affected by a sense of eternity (verse 11). Thank God that "our times are in His hand" and we can know his Lordship over every area of our lives:

[Ecclesiastes chapter three and v1] There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under heaven:

- [v2] a time to be born and a time to die, a time to plant and a time to uproot,
- [v3] a time to kill and a time to heal, a time to tear down and a time to build,
- [v4] a time to weep and a time to laugh, a time to mourn and a time to dance,

- [v5] a time to scatter stones and a time to gather them, a time to embrace and a time to refrain,
- [v6] a time to search and a time to give up, a time to keep and a time to throw away,
- [v7] a time to tear and a time to mend, a time to be silent and a time to speak,
- [v8] a time to love and a time to hate, a time for war and a time for peace.
- [v9] What does the worker gain from his toil?
- [v10] I have seen the burden God has laid on men.
- [v11] He has made everything beautiful in its time. He has also set eternity in the hearts of men; yet they cannot fathom what God has done from beginning to end.
