Pray for God to be at work in their lives today and every day so that they will fulfill God's purposes for the whole of their earthly lives.

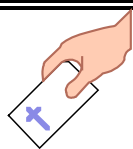
[Eph 2:10] *"For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do."*
