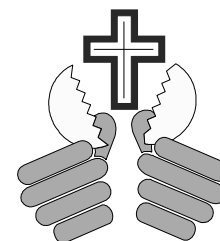

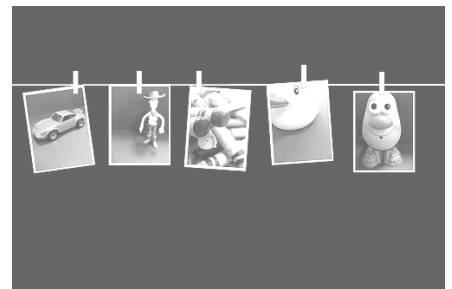
KINGDOM KIDS

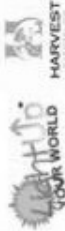

PRAYERS FOR THE 6TH SUNDAY AFTER TRINITY

Creator God,
you made us all in your image:
may we discern you in all that we see,
and serve you in all that we do;
through Jesus Christ our Lord.



We pray that:

“the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints, and his incomparably great power for us who believe.” [Eph 1:18 &19]

Pray for increasing awareness of all who God is, all that God has done for us and the riches of His promises to us in Jesus.

May the true and living hope that God gives us encourage us to face life positively and generously in whatever circumstances we find ourselves.

Continue to pray for all of the needs of Shatin church: for the person of God’s calling to be the new pastor; for appropriate accommodation for office and ministry needs; for our giving to be sustained (and even grow!) over the summer period.

Pray for Misha Del Favero in Dancalan. Give thanks for her faith and love for the people in this part of the Philippines.

She has recently informed us of a water shortage in her area, this extract from an email she sent can form the basis for our prayer for her:

One more prayer request: Rain! There has been no running water here during the day for months now. Water only comes back at night, sometimes as late as midnight! Some people get up at 2:00 A.M. to wash clothes and refill water drums in preparation for the next day. The reason for this? Lack of rain. Last year, it rained almost non-stop from January or before until May or June, so water lasted throughout the year. Only occasionally was there a day where we had no running water. This year, barely any rain has fallen. The weather is hot and dry, and now the water supply seems to be drying up. Tita Belen told me that, the other night, the water stopped flowing at 4:00 A.M., and it was reddish-brown in color. I thought, “Oh, no... That sounds like it’s getting to the end of it, soaking up the soil now.” When I first learned about the water problem, I tried to ignore the thought of drought. But now it seems like a real possibility, unless... rain! We need rain! Please pray!

Around the world we pray for the situation in Thailand where the government has extended a state of emergency in 19 provinces, including the capital Bangkok, because of fears of renewed violence. Pray for the exercise of just and righteous government and respect for human life and avoidance of violence by all sides.

NOTES FOR OUR SERMON TODAY

[Isa 49:1] Listen to me, you islands; hear this, you distant nations: Before I was born the LORD called me; from my birth he has made mention of my name.

[Isa 49:2] He made my mouth like a sharpened sword, in the shadow of his hand he hid me; he made me into a polished arrow and concealed me in his quiver.

[Isa 49:3] He said to me, "You are my servant, Israel, in whom I will display my splendor."

[Isa 49:4] But I said, "I have labored to no purpose; I have spent my strength in vain and for nothing. Yet what is due me is in the LORD's hand, and my reward is with my God."

[Isa 49:5] And now the LORD says-- he who formed me in the womb to be his servant to bring Jacob back to him and gather Israel to himself, for I am honored in the eyes of the LORD and my God has been my strength--

[Isa 49:6] he says: "It is too small a thing for you to be my servant to restore the tribes of Jacob and bring back those of Israel I have kept. I will also make you a light for the Gentiles, that you may bring my salvation to the ends of the earth."

[Isa 49:7] This is what the LORD says-- the Redeemer and Holy One of Israel-- to him who was despised and abhorred by the nation, to the servant of rulers: "Kings will see you and rise up, princes will see and bow down, because of the LORD, who is faithful, the Holy One of Israel, who has chosen you."

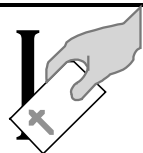
