PRAYER TRIPLETS

After Chinese New Year we are resuming the highly successful "prayer triplets" scheme.

TRIPLETS are where people sign up and are allocated to a group of three people for three months at a time;

By signing up we agree to meet together three times (short meetings that could be for coffee, lunch or a meal before or after work) to share with two other people the answers to three questions ("How are you doing with the Lord?" "What can we pray for you at the moment?" "What do you give thanks for at the moment?").

People may well keep in touch via SMS email or phone in addition to the meetings but this provides a way for busy people to know that others are praying for them. After the three months the triplets are re-formed with at least one different person for those who wish to continue.



PRAYERS FOR THE 3RD SUNDAY BEFORE LENT

Eternal God, whose Son went among the crowds and brought healing with his touch: help us to show his love, in your Church as we gather together, and by our lives as they are transformed into the image of Christ our Lord.

Pray for the work of God's Spirit in us transforming us more and more into the likeness of Jesus. Pray particularly for the effect of the "You've got the time – Hong Kong" campaign as we listen to the New Testament during the 40 days leading up to Easter; pray that God will work by His Spirit through His Word.

<u>55:10</u>	As the rain and the snow
	come down from heaven,
	and do not return to it
	without watering the earth
	and making it bud and flourish,
	so that it yields seed for the sower and bread for the eater,
<u>11</u> 9	so is my word that goes out from my mouth:
	It will not return to me empty,
	but will accomplish what I desire
	and achieve the purpose for which I sent it. (Isaiah 55 verses 10 & 11)

We are in the final stages of interviews and conversations with a candidate for the post of Pastor of Shatin Anglican Church. Pray that God confirms His will in the hearts and minds of all those involved in making this appointment and that the person concerned will come to us as the person God will use to lead us into the next phase of the church's life, mission and ministry.

We continue to pray for the social unrest in the middle east; continue to pray that social changes will be possible without violence and that social stability and spiritual freedom will enable the gospel to spread without hindrance.

NOTES FOR OUR SERMON TODAY – EPHESIANS 4 VERSES 17 TO 32 "LIFE WORTH LIVING – NEW AND RENEWED"

4:17 So I tell you this, and insist on it in the Lord, that you must no longer live as the Gentiles do, in the futility of their thinking. 18 They are darkened in their understanding and separated from the life of God because of the ignorance that is in them due to the hardening of their hearts. 19 Having lost all sensitivity, they have given themselves over to sensuality so as to indulge in every kind of impurity, with a continual lust for more.

4:20 You, however, did not come to know Christ that way. 21 Surely you heard of him and were taught in him in accordance with the truth that is in Jesus. 22 You were taught, with regard to your former way of life, to put off your old self, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires; 23 to be made new in the attitude of your minds; 24 and to put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness.

4:25 Therefore each of you must put off falsehood and speak truthfully to his neighbor, for we are all members of one body. 26 "In your anger do not sin": Do not let the sun go down while you are still angry, 27 and do not give the devil a foothold. 28 He who has been stealing must steal no longer, but must work, doing something useful with his own hands, that he may have something to share with those in need.

4:29 Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen. 30 And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. 31 Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice. 32 Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.
