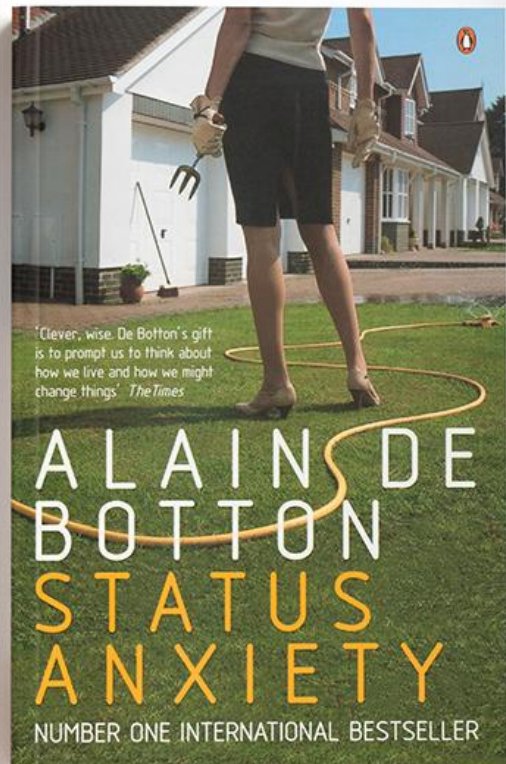


# True Humility

## 1. Humility – It's Wise!

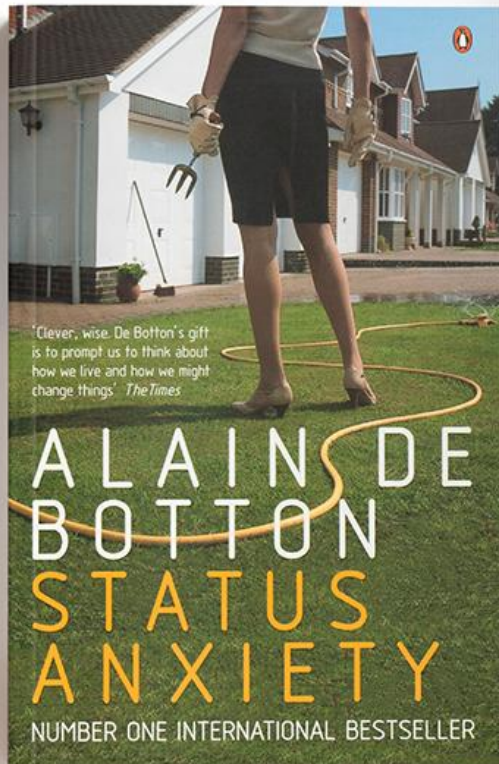
- Don't brag, because you might be humiliated
- Don't live and work to elevate your status, because Jesus will judge differently.
- "For all those who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted" (v.11).
